## **Action Plan**

- Project-Based Learning (PBL): Engage students in hands-on projects to deepen understanding and foster practical application of sustainability concepts.
- To embed project-based learning (PBL) throughout the school, a comprehensive whole-school approach will be adopted. Assembly sessions will be utilized to introduce key PBL concepts. Events and competitions will be organized that engage the entire school to encourage creativity and deepen student engagement in sustainability-focused learning.
